- 2. To give drink to the thirsty
- 3. To clothe the naked
- 4. To visit the prisoner
- 5. To shelter the homeless
- 6. To visit the sick
- 7. To bury the dead

### Spiritual Works of Mercy

- 1. Correct the sinner
- 2. Instruct the ignorant
- 3. Counsel the doubting
- 4. Comfort the sorrowful
- 5. Be patient with those in error
- 6. Forgive offenses
- 7. Pray for the living and the dead
