### SPECIAL APPEAL FOR UKRAINE

Pope Francis has launched a special appeal for humanitarian aid for Ukraine. This weekend, 23<sup>rd</sup>/24<sup>th</sup> April, 50°/o of the ordinary SHARE Collection will be donated to the Holy Father's appeal.

The armed conflict in eastern Ukraine began in Spring 2014 and, notwithstanding the ceasefire of September 2015, continues still, resulting in causalities caused by a vast number of landmines and constant artillery fire. The number of dead ascertained is approximately 9,000 and many other people are displaced or imprisoned, often illegally. There are more than 500,000 people who are in urgent need of food. There are over 1.5 million people displaced throughout the country.
