**John Henry Newman's Lecture**

In anticipation of John Henry Newman's (Founder of UCD) canonisation in Rome on 13 Oct 2019, UCD Chaplaincy are organising a public lecture by the leading internationally recognised Newman Scholar, Professor Ian Ker (Oxford University). This will take place in the George Moore Auditorium (O'Brien Science wing) at 7.00pm on Wednesday 9 October. We will also have a panel of experts (Dr. Daire Keogh, Deputy President DCU; Dr. Kathleen Lynch, Prof Emeritus UCD; and Joanna Siewierska, UCD SU President) to respond to Prof Ian's paper and to stimulate audience participation. The title of the paper will be of general interest to educationalists: 'Useful or Useless? John Henry Newman's Vision of Liberal Education TODAY'. All are welcome. Light refreshments will be served.
